Hilltop Camp Conduct Agreement

Hilltop Camp is a Christian camp. All rules are to help us in our conduct and reflect Christ in all we do.

- Please respect all camp grounds, facilities, furnishings, and equipment. We ask you to assist in keeping the ground clean of trash.
- Items not permitted on this campground include illegal drugs, alcoholic beverages, knives, any form of tobacco, guns, skateboards, fireworks, radios, CD or tape players (unless used in camp program by camp staff), iPods, MP3 players, game boys, DVD player, other media players, and bad attitudes.
- Cell phones may be used to contact parents or guardians. Cell phones may be used only with permission of the camp director.
- Shoes must be worn at all times.
- Shorts are permitted to be worn. Shorts must be modest, which means no short shorts, Daisy Dukes, etc.
- Swimsuits may be worn during water games only and must be modest in style. Swimsuits must be onepiece (no two-piece suits). No Speedo briefs (or similar) are permitted.
- ➤ Hats may not be worn during worship sessions.
- Clothing which is revealing in style (for example: spaghetti-strap tops, halter tops, muscle shirts) or advertising of products or values inconsistent with Hilltop Camp values will not be permitted.
- Physical challenge facilities, including but not limited to the ropes course, zipline, and climbing wall, may only be experienced with the approval and presence of camp-authorized personnel.
- > Campers must attend all sessions and participate in all activities for which they are scheduled.
- > No one is permitted to enter the dorm of the opposite sex for any reason.
- Campers are not permitted into any private spaces, such as staff sleeping rooms, or food preparation areas.
- Automobiles are to be parked in designated locations and not used for meetings, resting places, or any other type of gatherings. Campers may not enter a vehicle, except for the purpose of departure from the camp.
- Public display of affection between campers is not permitted in public or private settings.
- Medication of all types must be checked in with the camp nurse upon arrival to camp and may be taken only at the direction or under the supervision of the nurse.
- Once checked in, campers must formally check in and check out in order to leave the property and return. Any such activity can only occur with the written permission of a parent or guardian, which must be submitted to the camp director in person.
- Dorm rooms and bunk areas must be kept orderly and clean. Furniture, fixtures, and personal items may not block windows, which may be used in cases of emergency. Sleeping areas must be kept free of uncontained food, trash, and wet clothing and linens.

- "Lights-out" for sleeping hours is strictly enforced for the safety and well-being of campers and counselors.
- Each camper will be assigned a counselor. Counselors serve campers as their fearless leaders and must be respected.
